200 ~ Pieced Bed Quilt—Predominantly pieced by hand or machine.

300 ~ Appliqué Wall Quilt—Predominantly appliquéd quilts; any one side does not exceed 60 inches.

400 ~ Appliqué Bed Quilt—Predominantly appliquéd quilts.

500 ~ Mixed Media Wall Quilt—Quilts with equal amounts of appliqué and piecing; any one side does not exceed 60 inches.

600 ~ Mixed Media Bed Quilt—Quilts with equal amounts of appliqué and piecing.

700 ~ Other Techniques—Wholecloth, Crazy Quilts, embroidered Stained Glass, Cathedral Windows, any quilt that doesn't fit into the other categories. (All sizes)

800 ~ Art / Innovative Quilt—Quilts reflecting substantial deviation from the traditional patterns and sets. (All techniques) Emphasis is on color, line, design and original work of artist.

900 ~ Two Person Quilt—A quilt that is made by two people (*quilt top made by one person and quilted by another*).

1000 ~ Group Quilt—Quilt that is made by three (3) or more people must be entered in this category.

1100 ~ Garments—Garment featuring patchwork, appliqué, embellishment or other needle art. Must contain a recognizable amount of quilting and consist of three layers.

#### Entry Rules and Regulations



#### ELIGIBILITY:

Any quilt maker who is a member in good standing of the Colorado Quilting Council may submit a quilt/garment that meets the following criteria:

- A. Item must have been completed after January 1, 2008.
- B. Quilts must consist of three layers: top, batting, and backing, and be quilted by hand, machine or a combination of both. No tied comforters or kits will be accepted.
- C. Quilts must have a 4" finished sleeve attached to the full width of the top edge of the quilt. *(For sleeve instructions please contact Karen Roxburgh at 720 898-0249 or kkquilting@yahoo.com).*
- D. Every entry must have your name, address and quilt name on the back of the quilt prominently displayed on a permanent label or on the sleeve. All garments must also be labeled.
- E. All entries must be clean, free of pet hair, smoke and odor. CQC reserves the right to disqualify any quilt that does not meet show criteria, exhibits poor quality construction, or has been misrepresented by the photo, requires special handling or cannot be folded for shipping. Entry placed in the wrong category by the entrant will be judged and displayed, but will not be eligible for awards.

#### REGISTRATION AND ENTRY FEE

- A. **Entry form with original signature must be received on or before April 24, 2010. Non refundable entry fee of \$10.00 per quilt/garment (plus \$20.00 prepaid postage to return quilt by mail) in the form of a check or money order made payable to "Quilt Colorado 2010" and 2 photos.** Please note this is different from past years in which slides have been requested. One photo must show the full quilt/garment and the other a close-up shot showing details of quilting. Also, please note that the photos will not be returned and become the property of CQC. **You must also include with your entry form a Large Self Addressed #10 Envelope with postage.** This envelope will be mailed back to you with pertinent information. You will learn if your quilt was accepted for the show and if so, you will receive an entry card that is to be safety pinned to the cloth bag of your entry. **No entry will be taken without this entry form attached to the cloth bag.**
- B. **Limit 2 quilts/garments per person.** One item per entry form. **One item per category.** All juried quilts/garments should be in the hands of the Entry Chairperson or delivered to a designated pick-up point no later than June 5, 2010.
- C. Each quilt must be in a cloth bag with your name, address, and phone number permanently marked on the bag. **Safety pin the Entry Card to the outside of the bag.** One quilt per bag. *Quilts will not be accepted in plastic bags.*

#### PICK UP ARRANGEMENTS

Items will be returned as directed on your Entry Form. For members picking up quilts at the event, **quilts may be picked up between 1:00—2:00 pm on Sunday, June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2010 at the Holiday Inn, Estes Park.** After June 25<sup>th</sup>, 2010, quilts can be picked up at the shop where they were dropped off or will be returned by mail if prepaid postage of \$20.00 was included with the original entry form.

#### CATEGORIES

- 100 ~ **Pieced Wall Quilt**—Predominantly pieced by hand or machine; any one side does not exceed 60 inches.
- 200 ~ **Pieced Bed Quilt**—Predominantly pieced by hand or machine.
- 300 ~ **Appliqué Wall Quilt**—Predominantly appliquéd quilts; any one side does not exceed 60 inches.
- 400 ~ **Appliqué Bed Quilt**—Predominantly appliquéd quilts.
- 500 ~ **Mixed Media Wall Quilt**—Quilts with equal amounts of appliqué and piecing; any one side does not exceed 60 inches.
- 600 ~ **Mixed Media Bed Quilt**—Quilts with equal amounts of appliqué and piecing.
- 700 ~ **Other Techniques**—Wholecloth, Crazy Quilts, embroidered Stained Glass, Cathedral Windows, any quilt that doesn't fit into the other categories. *(All sizes)*
- 800 ~ **Art / Innovative**—Quilts reflecting substantial deviation from the traditional patterns and sets. Any one side does not exceed 60 inches. Emphasis is on color, line, design and **original work of artist.** *(All techniques)*
- 900 ~ **Two Person Quilt**—A quilt that is made by two people *(quilt top made by one person and quilted by another).*
- 1000 ~ **Group Quilt**—Quilt that is made by three (3) or more people must be entered in this category.
- 1100 ~ **Garments**—Garment featuring patchwork, appliqué, embellishment or other needle art. Must contain a recognizable amount of quilting, and consist of three layers.

#### QUILT SIZE DEFINITIONS

**Wall Quilt:** Any quilt made for display on a wall, and any one side does not exceed 60 inches.

**Bed Quilt:** Any quilt made for the bed, any one side exceeds 60 inches.
