ELIGIBILITY

Any quilt maker may submit a quilt that meets the following criteria:

- A. Quilt may not have been entered in a previous Quilt Colorado quilt show.
- B. Quilt must consist of three layers: top, batting and backing and be quilted by hand, machine or a combination of both.
- C. Kit quilts and block-of-the-month quilts which include fabric in the kit may not be entered in the judged show. However, they may be entered in the non-judged/display only category.
- D. Quilt must have a 4 inch finished sleeve attached to the full width of the top edge of the quilt. A quilt over 90 inches in length will drape onto a sheet on the floor.
- E. Quilt must have your name, address and quilt name on the back of the quilt prominently displayed on a permanent label or on the sleeve. Cover the label.
- F. Quilt must be clean, free of pet hair, smoke and odor. CQC reserves the right to disqualify any quilt that does not meet show criteria, exhibits poor quality construction or has been misrepresented by the photo, requires special handling or cannot be folded for shipping.
- G. A quilt entered in the wrong category will be moved to a category in which it can be fairly judged.

REGISTRATION AND ENTRY FEE

- A. Entry form with original signature must be postmarked by May 18, 2012. Non refundable entry fee of \$10 per quilt (plus \$25.00 prepaid postage to return quilt by mail) and two photos. One photo must show the full quilt and the other a close-up showing details of quilting. Photos may be printed on photo paper, be submitted on a CD or e-mailed to lanaheyer@yahoo.com. Mark the photos, CD or e-mail clearly with your name and the quilt name. Photos will not be returned and become the property of CQC. Also include a large stamped self-addressed #10 envelope.
- B. Limit 2 quilts per person. One quilt per entry form.

QUILT DROP

OFF/SHIPPING ARRANGEMENTS

- A. If your quilt is accepted, you will receive an entry card that is to be safety-pinned to the cloth bag containing your quilt. No entry will be taken without this entry card attached to the cloth bag.
- B. All juried (accepted) quilts must be in the hands of the designated pick-up points listed below no later than July 3, 2012.
- C. Each quilt must be in a cloth bag with your name, address, and phone number permanently marked on the bag. **Safety-pin the Entry Card to the outside of the bag.** One quilt per bag. Quilts will not be accepted in plastic bags.

CATEGORIES

Quilt Size Definitions

Small – Any one side does not exceed 60 inches

Large – Any one side is 60 inches or greater

Pieced – Small Predominantly pieced.

Pieced – Large Predominantly pieced.

Applique - Small Predominantly appliqued

Applique - Large Predominantly appliqued.

Mixed Media - Small Quilts with equal amounts of appliqué and piecing.

Mixed Media - Large Quilts with equal amounts of appliqué and piecing.

Other Techniques Wholecloth, crazy quilts, embroidered, stained glass, cathedral windows. Any quilt that doesn't fit into the other categories (*all sizes*).

Art/Innovative Quilts reflecting substantial deviation from the traditional patterns and sets. Emphasis is on color, line, design and original work of artist (*all techniques and sizes*).

Two Person - Small A quilt that is made by two people (*such as quilt top made by one person and quilted by another*).

Two Person - Large A quilt that is made by two people (*such as quilt top made by one person and quilted by another*).

Group Quilt that is made by three or more people must be entered in this category.

Non-judged/Display Only Quilt will not be judged and is not eligible for cash prizes.
